- Maintenance of tools necessary for serial production.
- Preparing training plan of production operators.

- Provide engineering support to operations to ensure stable, efficient production.
- Troubleshoot equipment issues and propose engineering solutions.
- Define and maintain production standards (cycle time, labor, material usage).
- Create documentation: work instructions, process flow charts, control plans.
- Participate in audits and corrective action plans.
